Dear Faithful Supporters and Friends,

A few years ago the country of Guyana found oil off-shore. Exxon-Mobil is here drilling and pumping it for the country. The oil boom has brought many foreign investors. Along with that, there are also many here seeking jobs and a better life. Many Spanish-speaking people are here from Venezuela and Cuba as refugees. We could never have imagined years ago that God would bring these different people groups from other nations to our otherwise, little and unknown country. We have the opportunity to reach them with the Gospel.

About a year ago, a couple of our older teen boys began taking every other Sunday afternoon, after the morning service, to go soul winning. Not long ago, they invited a Spanish-speaking man to the church. He came, got saved, and was baptized. Pray for us that we can develop a Spanish ministry for those that are Spanish-speaking. Guyana is the only English-speaking country in South America, and I don't speak Spanish. Pray that God will raise up someone from our church to learn Spanish, or for God to send someone who already speaks Spanish to help us.

Dakari, a teen boy from our bus route who was mentioned in our previous letter, got baptized, as he promised. A young girl got baptized recently who was saved a year ago in our VBS. She and her family have been attending our church ever since VBS last year.

In May and June we had a total of **83** saved and **5** baptized in the ministry. In August we will have VBS, youth conference, and teen camp. We will appreciate your prayers for these events.

At present, we are in the US for a couple of weeks to help our son get started in flight school in Indianapolis. He will be working on his commercial pilot's license. We would appreciate your prayers for him and for us, as we will be going back to the field for the first time with no children. It will be a very strange feeling and a time of big adjustment for us to say the least.

Thank you for keeping up with us all these many years. We pray that will continue as we continue on the journey of going and preaching the gospel of peace to those who have yet to hear (Rom. 10:15).
