He had been really interested about Christ, and I shared the gospel with him. Thankfully, he was still interested, and we were able to talk again and answer another one of his questions about God. He came 15 May, and we introduced him to the church family in preparation for our departure on 22 May. On 17 May, Ira and the ladies attended a ladies' banquet at Calvary Baptist Church. We had seven in attendance from our church, and they all enjoyed the fellowship greatly. During the last couple of weeks while we have been gone, we have had a couple visitors and even a profession of faith! This was an answer to a specific prayer that God would bring visitors and salvations during our time away.

Upcoming Events: We have a busy June and July ahead. We are planning a Family Fun Day on 20 June and a Youth Night on 6 July when we will have some help from Bro. John and some students from Pensacola Christian College. On 9-11 July, we have young adults' camp. On 17-19 July, we have some special meetings including a Bible Conference focusing on Discipleship taught by Dr. Dan Troutman, a Bible teacher at PCC. Finally, on 26-27 July, we have a hymns concert and special service for our first church anniversary planned. There is a lot to prepare once we return to Melbourne. We would really appreciate your prayers for all these events, and most important, that God would work in and through us as we do these events.
