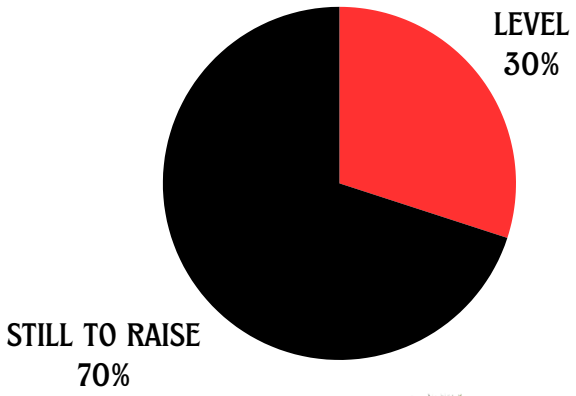
SUPPORT LEVEL
