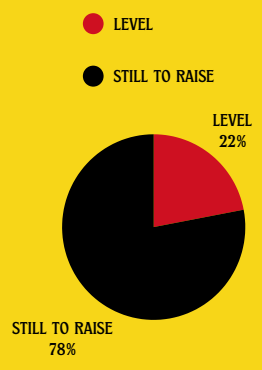

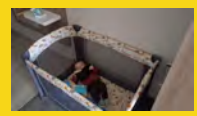
OVERVIEW
