In Indiana, we experienced our first tornado warning in the camper; we enjoyed beautiful, sunny skies while alligators sunbathed near us in the crystal springs of Florida. Through it all we are thankful for God's safety over every mile. We have been humbled and overwhelmed time and again as we have witnessed God provide our every need, often times, before we even ask him.
