Thank you for your faithful prayer and support for our family and ministry here in Montreal! The Lord is at work and we're grateful to share with you some specific blessings in our lives.

Spiritual Growth: During the recent youth conference in Ontario, one of the young men in our church made a decision to be baptized. It was a privilege to baptize him on the first weekend of May and to watch him take this next step of obedience. During the month of June, there were four children saved in our church, three of whom made this decision during our regular children's class on Sunday morning. We're now in the midst of our Vacation Bible School this week (June 29-July 3) and are praising the Lord for a tremendous attendance and evident working of the Spirit. We're so thankful for this opportunity to connect with many families in our community.

Upcoming Ministry Prayer Requests: There are several regular attendees in the church who are interested in becoming members; we look forward to starting this process with them with a new members' class during the month of July. We also are planning and hosting a bi-lingual youth rally at the church on July 31st. This will be a wonderful opportunity to reach the young people in our region and to provide them with spiritual resources.
